



Overnight Horse Accommodations at Letchworth Farm Guesthouses. Please read thoroughly prior to booking your stay.

Overnight horse accommodations are available from May 1st- November 1st

For guests who are staying in one of our guesthouses we offer the option to trailer in your own horses to either use one our property or to ride into one of the local parks.

A general release of liability and short-term boarding waiver must be signed and returned 24 hours prior to your stay. These forms can be found under our forms tab.

A current negative Coggins is required while staying on the farm and must be provided within 24 hours of your stay date. If this is not provided prior to the 24 hours, we reserve the right to cancel your booking, and no refund will be given.

State parks may require other documentation including health certificates, and rabies vaccinations. We recommend following all rules and regulations as set forth by the parks but do not enforce these requirements on the farm.

There is ample trailer parking below our indoor riding arena with gravel driveway in and out with turn around by the horse stalls. At this time, we do not allow camping or have trailer hook-ups.

As a guest on the farm, you do have access to the property which includes an outdoor riding arena, indoor riding arena, wash stall, bathrooms, showers, wooded trails. We ask that you give the right of way to our trail guide operations which run year-round. You will not have access to the indoor arena while trail ride operations are occurring. A daily schedule will be posted in the barn for reference to the best of our ability.

Please be courteous of our trail riders and horses. Please give them the right of way on the trail. Please do not gallop up behind them, or towards them.

There is no smoking on the farm.

The tack room within the main barn is off limits to guests.

We do not allow dogs and other animals onto the farm for overnight stays. There are no exceptions.

Horses are provided with a 12x12 stall and 1 bag of shavings. The stalls will be set up prior to your arrival. Must bring your own shavings/bedding. Extra shavings/pellet bedding is offered for sale if needed.

Boarders must supply their own grain/supplements.

Each stall has an automatic waterer from our well and fans.

Owners must clean up after their own horses and care for their own horses while staying. We supply pitchforks, buckets, wheelbarrows, and a manure pile that is conveniently located behind the barn. We do not provide any care to horses that are not owned by us.

Please turn off the lights and shut the barn doors when you are done for the day.

The indoor arena closes as dusk.
